



Counseling Information for College Credit Plus Participation 2025-2026

After reviewing the related CCP materials, and/or attending the CCP Family Info Meeting, families should print and sign this form acknowledging understanding of CCP policies and guidelines.

Please, return the signed form to the Main Office by March 15, 2025.

- Ohio's College Credit Plus can help students earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from colleges or universities;
- Families should discuss and carefully weigh the options of participating in CCP as courses contain college level material, move at a faster pace, and require the maturity to work independently and meet deadlines;
- Families must follow the required steps and meet the appropriate deadlines established by the ODE in order to participate in CCP and receive state funding;
- Colleges require families to complete a Mature Content Waiver with information about the potential for mature subject matter, as defined in section 3365.035 of the Revised Code;
- Students must be accepted into individual colleges; each college has its own set of admission requirements which may include some type of testing. The college application will list specific requirements, families should contact colleges directly for admission, testing, and orientation requirements;
- If a student does not apply to the CCP program or meet the deadlines, they may still participate in college classes and receive college credit if they have applied and been accepted to the college. This is considered "Dual Enrollment" and would be self-pay (currently around \$42-43 per credit hour depending on the college. Colleges will bill the family directly;
- CCP courses are transcribed and are guaranteed to transfer to Ohio public colleges, however, private colleges or out of state institutions have the right to accept or deny transfer credits toward a degree. Courses may count towards elective credits. Please see: <https://transfercredit.ohio.gov> or specific universities to inquire about transfer credits;
- There are two options for funding CCP courses, **Plan A** where families can self-pay the standard rate for courses, books and fees and have the option to have courses and grades included on high school transcripts or **Plan B** where families use CCP funding to pay for course work;
- If a student receives a failing grade in a course, it will appear on both the high school and the college transcript. A student is placed on academic CCP Probation with the college when he/she either has earned lower than a cumulative 2.0 GPA in CCP courses or withdraws from/receives no credit for two or more courses in the same term;
- If a student fails a college course or drops the course after the roster withdrawal date, the family may be responsible for payment of tuition of that course and repayment of any textbook costs;
- Funding is limited and not all students who wish to participate may be able to do so;

- When student's register for classes, they must submit the Funding Award letter to each higher education institution they attend and meet their application deadlines;
- Nonpublic students that were not awarded all of the requested credits in their Funding Award (Option B) may take additional courses under Option A and self-pay;
- CCP students are permitted to earn a maximum of 30 semester hours (through any combination of courses between the high school and college) per year. Each 3 (or more) semester hour college course = 1 high school credit;
